

This Privacy Policy is intended to describe the management methods of the site [www.dipromed.eu](http://www.dipromed.eu), with reference to the processing of personal data of the users / visitors who consult it. This policy is given only for the above mentioned site and not for other websites possibly consulted by the user through specific links.

**DIPRO MEDICAL DEVICES S.R.L.** guarantees compliance with the legislation on the protection of personal data (Reg. 2016/679 EU and Legislative Decree 196/03). Users / visitors are therefore asked to carefully read this Privacy Policy before submitting any personal information and / or filling in any electronic form on this site.

### **Owner of the data processing**

The Company Dipro Medical Devices S.r.l. (from now only "Dipromed") with registered office in San Mauro Torinese (TO) is the owner of the processing of personal data.

### **Types of processed data**

#### Navigation data

The IT systems and applications dedicated to the functioning of this site acquire, during their normal functioning, some personal data (whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols) not associated with directly identifiable Users. Those information could, by their nature, through associations and processes with data held by third parties, allow identifying users / visitors (eg IP address, names of computer domains used by users / visitors connecting to the site, etc.). These data are used for the time strictly necessary only for statistical information (and are, therefore, anonymous) and to check the correct functioning of the site. No data deriving from the web service will be communicated or disseminated.

#### Data voluntarily provided by users / visitors

The voluntary and explicit sending of e-mail to the addresses indicated in the different access channels of this site and the compilation of specifically prepared forms implicate the subsequent acquisition of the address and the sender / user data, necessary to reply to the requests produced and / or provide the requested service.

#### Cookies

Computer techniques for the direct acquisition of personal identification data of the user are not used in any way.

So-called session cookies are not stored after the termination of the connection to the Dipromed website.

### **Purpose of the processing**

Dipromed carries out the personal data processing within the limits of what is strictly necessary for the performance of the social purposes, excluding the treatment when the aims can be achieved by anonymous data or by means that permit to identify the interested party only in case of need.

Specific purposes related to individual treatments may be detailed reported in the various access channels. Within them, the User can find additional information on the personal data processing.

### **Processing methods**

The processing is carried out through automated tools (for example using electronic procedures and supports) and / or manually (for example on paper) for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purpose for which the data was collected and, in any case, in compliance with the regulations in force on the subject.

### **Optional supply of data**

The user is free to provide personal data contained in the application forms of the various services offered in the portal. Failure to provide the mandatory data required will make it impossible to obtain the service.

### **Communication and / or dissemination of data**

The personal data of users who request the sending of informative material, answers to questions, notices and newsletters, are used solely for the purpose of performing the service or provision requested and are communicated to third parties only in the cases in which:

- the communication is imposed by legal or regulatory obligations
- during a legal proceeding.

User data will not be disclosed. The processing operations connected to the web services of this site are handled exclusively by Dipromed technical personnel, in charge of processing.

### **Transfer of Data to a Third Country**

The European Data Protection Regulation provides for the obligation to inform interested parties in case of transfer of data about them to Third Countries (not belonging to the EU or to the European Economic Area: Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein) or international organizations.

The company, as Data Controller, informs those concerned that does not transfer data to third countries.

### **Place of data processing**

The processing operations connected to the web services of this site take place at the above-mentioned offices of the Data Controller.

### **Period of conservation**

The data collected by the Company, for the purposes previously indicated, will be kept for the time necessary to carry out the operations for which they are acquired. The retention period will be determined on the basis of the evaluation of the individual procedure and will take place, in any case, in compliance with the principles of necessity, purpose limitation, accuracy and storage limitation sanctioned pursuant to the Regulation.

### **Rights of interested parties**

The "interested parties", or natural persons, legal persons, authority or associations, to which the data refer, have the right, at any time, to obtain confirmation of the existence of the same data and to know its content and the origin, verify its accuracy or request its integration or updating, or the rectification pursuant to articles 15-22 of the European Regulation 679/2016. Pursuant to the same article, the interested parties also have the right to request cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data about them, processed in violation of the law, and to oppose in any case, for legitimate reasons, to their treatment . Moreover, the interested party may always lodge a complaint with the competent Guarantor Authority for the protection of personal data.
